

## The Japan Cup – 2016

Those performers who have the time and dedication to take a method that is not very difficult and turn it into a Miracle know – or will know – SIX quite well.

SIX is the owner of System 6 Magic Company. This is an innovative publisher of effects and playing cards and manufacturer of props that is making a huge “BUZZ” in the Magic world. When you come to The Japan Cup 2016 you will meet and be completely entertained by SIX. You will learn some of the BEST new Magic in the world.

. . . and you MAY just become one of System 6 newest artists!

SIX is looking for new effects, improvements on effects or methods of classic Magic, and new gimmicks or props that he will add to his most wonderful gallery of Magic that he makes available across the world. He wants to see what some guests at The Japan Cup have created, and he hopes YOU will be one of them!

Here are the basic facts:

- 1) All candidates MUST be registered for The Japan Cup 2016.
- 2) All candidates MUST submit a short video to SIX that will give him a good idea of what the candidate wants to have evaluated. These submissions MUST be in SIX’s possession by March 1, 2016.
- 3) SIX will select up to eight (8) candidates to speak with and review, in depth, their effect or improvement or gimmick or prop. He will meet with them at The Japan Cup on a date not yet set. He will then choose up to four (4) submissions to be part of The System SIX Magic Company.
- 4) SIX will video and make other arrangements at or after The Japan Cup. SIX will pay for all video and /or download production, all design and manufacturing, and all promotion. There IS NO COST TO SUBMIT OR BE PART OF THE PROJECT.
- 5) The artist would receive 25% of the profits for sale of the DVD or prop. This would be 30 – 40 days after the initial release of the item. The artist will also receive 100 units shipped to them; these are for the artist’s own sales; and there are no charges for the artist.

So, if you are interested – and we hope you are! – when you do register for The Japan Cup 2016, let SIX know by sending him an email with your name and email address and

BRIEF description of what you want him to consider. He will get back with you to inform you of the best way to send him a video of your creation.
